RUBIDOUX COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT RESIDENTIAL TRASH AND RECYCLING HOLIDAY COLLECTION SCHEDULE 2026

Holiday Schedule (No Service) Collection day will be 1 day behind schedule for the balance of the week. There is no service interruption or delay when the holiday falls on a Saturday or Sunday.

New Year's Day - January 1, 2026 (Thursday)*	Thanksgiving Day - November 26, 2026 (Thursday)*
Memorial Day - May 25, 2026 (Monday)*	Christmas Day - December 25, 2026 (Friday)*
Independence Day - July 4, 2026 (Saturday)	New Year's Day - January 1, 2027 (Friday)*
Labor Day - September 7, 2026 (Monday)*	* Street sweeping will be delayed one week.

Large or Bulky Items

Burrtec provides two residential curbside large or bulky item collections (maximum of 5 items per collection) during a 12-month period at no extra charge. Large or bulky items include: scrap metal, wood, old appliances, furniture, televisions, computer monitors, refrigerator or freezer, tree branches, mattresses, tires (limit 2), etc. We cannot collect large vehicle parts, or concrete and construction materials. Please call (951) 684-7580 one week prior to your scheduled collection day to arrange service pick-up.



Christmas Tree Recycling

Burrtec will collect and recycle natural Christmas trees from single-family residences. Please place your tree at the curbside after Christmas Day on your designated collection day. This service will be available from December 26th to January 17th. If your tree is six feet tall or more, please cut it in half. Ensure that all ornaments, lights, and stands are removed from the tree before placing it out for collection.

Please note that flocked trees are not recyclable and will be collected as trash. If you have a flocked tree that is six feet tall or more, please also cut it in half to facilitate disposal.
