ITEM 7. CORRESPONDENCE AND RELATED INFORMATION

The first article was about the Oroville Dam and the spillways that have been compromised. It's the first time since the dam has been completed that the spillway was ever used; nearly fifty years. All that water is just going to the river system down in the delta. The next article – conservation is still high, state water on state water officials. There's a push at the state level to have conservation as a way of life in California, regardless of the availability of water or lack of water they want to change habits and perception and conserve water. The next one is Drought dwindling in Southern California. Eastern MWD just relaxed their conservation from a stage 3 to a stage 1. Stage 1 encourages wasteful use of water.

Operations Report:

Jurupa is still taking about 1,700 gpm of water. That equates to about 2.5 ± million gallons per day.

The Incident Report for January 1 –January 31, 2017 there were a total of 282 calls, in comparison to the same period in 2016, there were a total of 281 calls. The year to date total is 282, compared to 281 in 2016.

ITEM 9. DM 2017-06. Receive and File Cash Asset Report Ending February 2017 for All District Fund Accounts.

The year-to-date Interest ending January 31, 2017, is \$81,142.00 for District controlled accounts. With respect to District "Funds in Trust", we show \$3,349.00 which has been earned and posted. The District has a combined YTD total of \$84,497.00 as of January 31, 2017.

With respect to the District's Operating Funds (Excluding Operating Reserves), we show a balance of \$4,858,556.00 ending January 31, 2017. That is **\$16,558.00 MORE** than July 1, 2016, beginning balance of \$4,841,998.00.

The District's Field/admin Fund continues to grow and current fund balance nears \$285,947.00.

ITEM 10. DM 2017-07. Present District's Water Replacement Program and Associated Projects to the Board.

The Rubidoux Community Services District has assessed and collected Water Replacement charges as part of monthly fixed and variable unit charges. In the early 1990's, the Water Replacement Fund was the brain-child of past RCSD Director Jim Gould and embraced by the full Board. When collected these monies are earmarked and segregated for needed repair and replacement of existing water infrastructure and appurtenances. Depending upon the season, typical assessment range from \$10,000.00± to \$15,000.00± per month. Incidentally, the Water Replacement Fund has a Fund Balance of \$527,081.30 as of January 31, 2017.

Tonight's presentation by Staff will revisit past Water Replacement Projects.

Mr. Steve Appel, District Engineer, presented a detailed presentation on the Water Replacement Program and Associated Projects to the Board.

The reason Rancho California Water District is pondering a rate hike

Despite storms, district expects needing to buy expensive imported water this summer due to the recent drawdown of Vail Lake.

Lake Oroville is overflowing. The pool in the backyard hasn't needed a splash of water for months. And the neighbor's formerly barren yard has a lush canopy of verdant weeds.

So why is the Rancho California Water District – which serves Temecula, Wine Country and some surrounding areas – warning customers about possible rate hikes later this year and urging conservation?

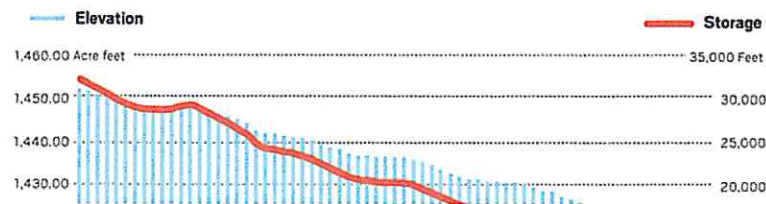
"This is the problem," Jeff Armstrong, the district's general manager, said Thursday. "Everyone's saying the drought's over. And you see what's happening in Northern California, the visuals."

The main issue, he said, is that this region, which has its own microclimate, is still recovering from a long period of below-average rainfall. In some years, he said, the region was getting less than half the rain it normally gets during a weather year.

During that time, the district used water from Vail Lake to augment the local supply, which, he said, helped keep rates lower than neighboring districts.

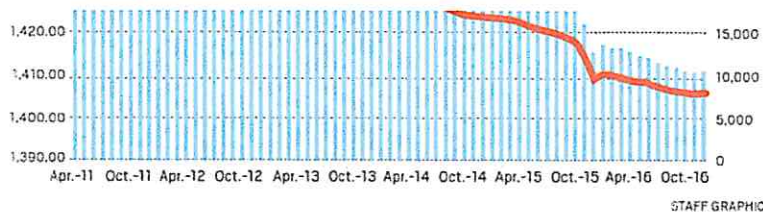

But the district – which imports around 60 percent to 75 percent of the 76,000 acre-feet it supplies each year – has drawn as much water as it can from the lake due to water quality issues: The lake needs enough water to allow sediment to sink to the bottom.

The recent storms, including this weekend’s deluge, have helped a lot – thousands of acre-feet have been added relatively quickly – but the lake is still about one-quarter of capacity and there is no plan any time soon to resume boat launches, which were suspended indefinitely due to the low water level.

In the past, the district wasn’t allowed to draw down the lake so severely because of a longstanding agreement that required a minimum elevation for recreation purposes.

That agreement was effectively voided when the district spent \$55 million to purchase the land surrounding the lake in a 2014 bankruptcy proceeding.

Armstrong said the investment helped the district bank about \$7.5 million in savings by using Vail Lake water instead of buying imported water.

Looking ahead, Armstrong said the district will be able to buy all the water it wants from the state water project, due to the tremendous rain and snowpack levels in the northern reaches of the state, but that water is considerably more expensive than local supply.

“We’re going to need a lot,” he said, noting the difference in cost runs about \$150 per acre-foot for local water versus \$1,000 an acre-foot for imported water.

An acre-foot of water equals 326,000 gallons, about the amount two families use in a typical year.

More water, but still more controls

California's water regulators just can't give up their control of our lawn watering and shower times, despite a federal analysis showing that most of the state is no longer in drought.

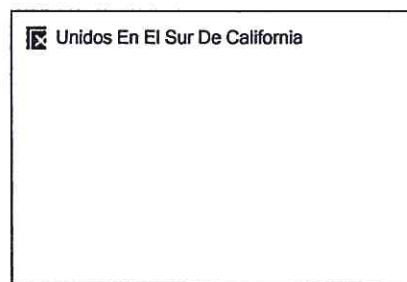
Even as Gov. Jerry Brown declared a state of emergency for 50 counties last month due to flooding, erosion and mud flows, and the snowpack in the Sierra Nevada is nearly twice average levels, the State Water Resources Control Board voted unanimously last week to extend water conservation rules until at least May.

In April 2015, Gov. Brown took the unprecedented step of imposing statewide water restrictions, ordering urban water agencies to reduce usage 25 percent below 2013 levels. Those rules were eased in May 2016, when the State Water Board lifted them for the 80 percent of water agencies able to show that they had three years of supply on hand. Those regulations had been set to expire at the end of the month.

Statewide water use for December 2016 was 20.6 percent lower than December 2013 levels, and cumulative savings from June 2015 through December 2016 were 22.5 percent, according to the board.

Just a couple of weeks ago, it was determined that, for the first time in three years, no part of the state was experiencing "exceptional drought," the worst of four drought categories. According to the U.S. Drought Monitor, less than 1 percent of the state is in "extreme drought," concentrated in southern Santa Barbara County and central Ventura County, and 11 percent is in "severe drought." Less than half the state is experiencing any drought at all, down from 95 percent a year ago.

Aside from the state's command-and-control tactics, and the question of whether restrictions are still necessary, the regulations also have other damaging effects. Many of the water agencies have voiced concerns that maintaining the restrictions while drought conditions have eased and reservoirs and snowpacks remain higher than normal could lead to a "boy who cried wolf" problem, damaging agencies' credibility with consumers.

“We just encourage the state to go ahead and let the word ‘emergency’ mean something, mean something serious, so that we can use it again,” Dave Bolland, director of state regulatory relations for the Association of California Water Agencies, told the State Water Board at its meeting.

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Moreover, as the San Diego County Water Authority noted, the restrictions have made it more difficult to attract and retain businesses.

Lest there be any doubt that control is a key factor at play here, Gov. Brown has directed the State Water Board to develop permanent conservation rules, including caps on indoor and outdoor water use, for implementation likely beginning next year.

Taxpayers have authorized tens of billions of dollars in water bonds over the past couple of decades, but we have precious little to show for it besides unnecessary pork-barrel projects and programs unrelated to actual infrastructure, such as land conservancy purchases, funding for parks and nature education facilities like museums and aquariums and programs for “sustainable communities.” Rather than micromanaging our landscaping and car washing behaviors, the state should get serious about increasing water storage capacity and other needed infrastructure.

Riverside County water supplier ditches most restrictions

Water bills may go down after Eastern Municipal Water District restores pre-drought emergency order rates for excessive or wasteful use

Eastern Municipal Water District dropped most water restrictions Wednesday – moving from measures taken to meet the state’s mandatory conservation orders to encouraging voluntary savings among customers.

While state bans on wasteful water use remain, the district board voted unanimously to end its own restrictions and return the water rate structure to pre-drought emergency order levels after supplies increased following heavy rain and snowfall, especially

in Northern California.

Western Riverside County remains in a moderate drought.

Since June 1, 2015, the district’s customers saved 28,000 acre-feet of water, or nearly 90 million gallons, over 2013 use – roughly what 56,000 households use in a year, said Eastern Municipal spokesman Kevin Pearson.

“Our customers stepped up,” he said. “The time is right for those restrictions to be eased.”

The district provides water to about 795,000 people living and working in a 555-square-mile area from Moreno Valley to Temecula, San Jacinto and Hemet.

On Feb. 8, the State Water Resources Control Board extended an amended statewide emergency water conservation regulation for 270 days, despite many water suppliers’ pleas for an end to the regulation.

The district board took action so quickly partly to maintain public trust, so customers know there’s an actual emergency the next time the district takes steps under its water shortage contingency plan, Pearson said.



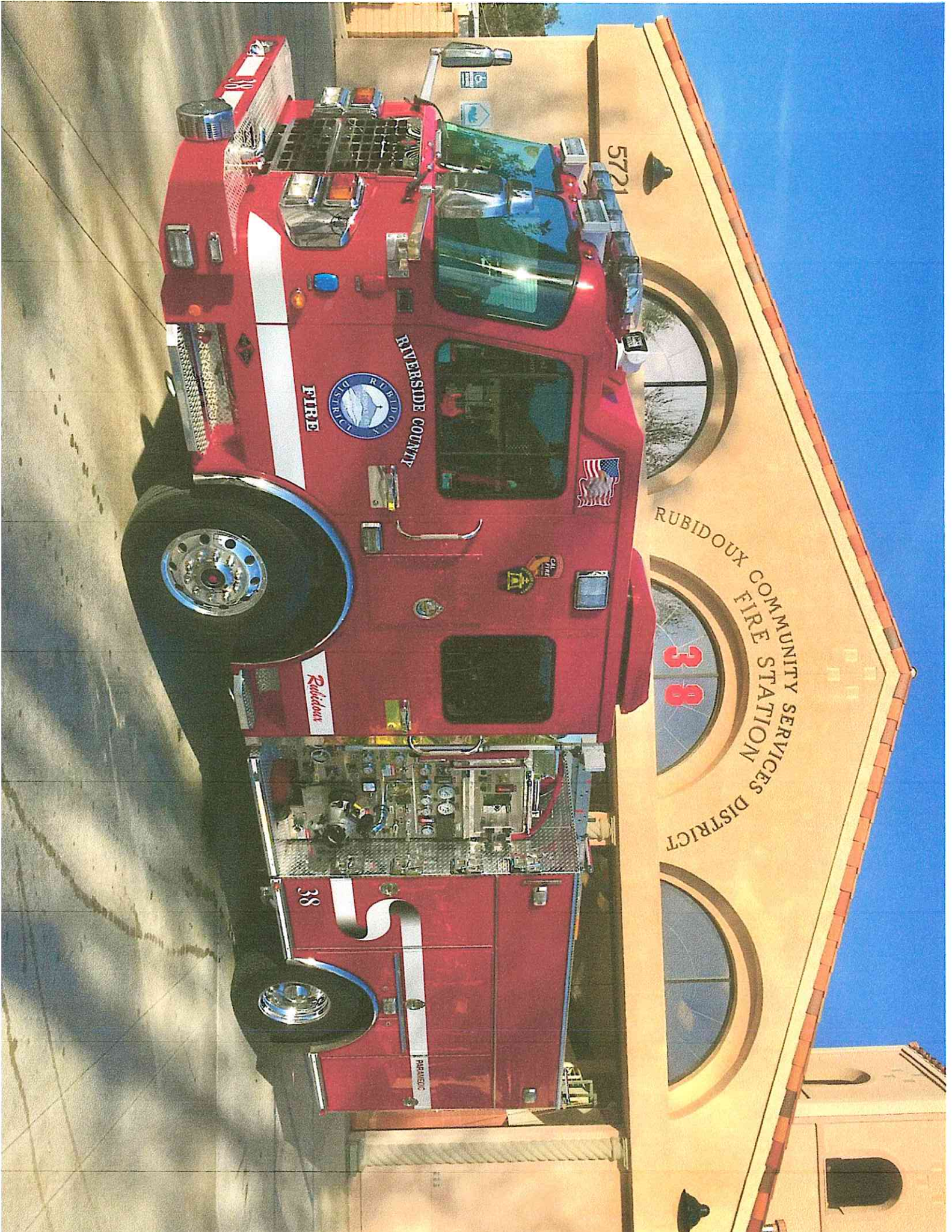

On February 22, 2017, the District received three (3) sealed bids for two (2) Water Department vehicles; Crest Chevrolet, Raceway Ford and Sunrise Ford. Attached for the Board of Director's consideration are two (2) vehicle bid summaries for a Water Department Trucks w/utility beds.

The Water Department is cycling out of service a 2009 Ford F150 truck with 52,000± miles. The above truck will be replaced by a submitted bid from Crest Chevrolet in San Bernardino with a new 2017 3/4 ton utility bed truck. 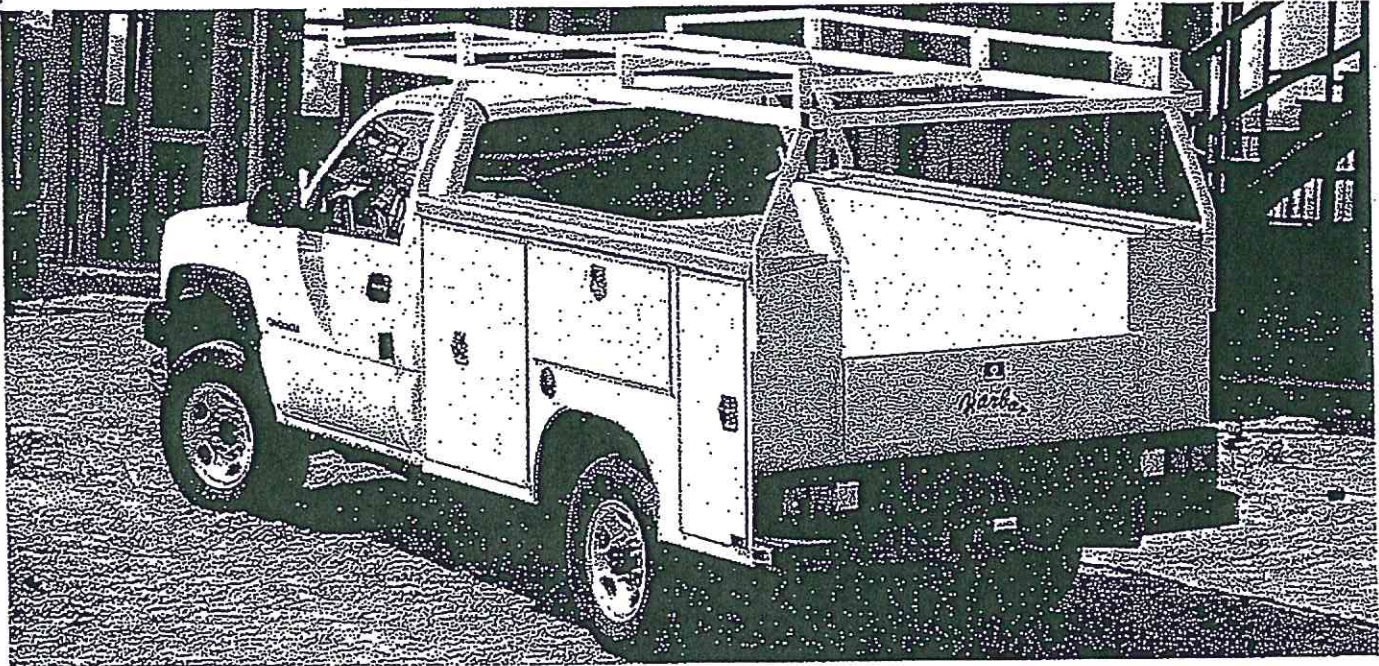


8 ft. Service Body Schematic



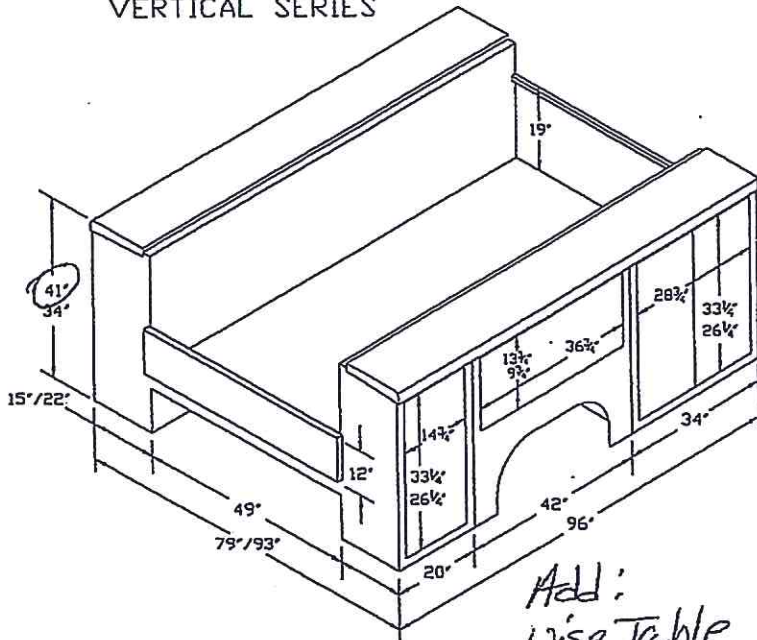

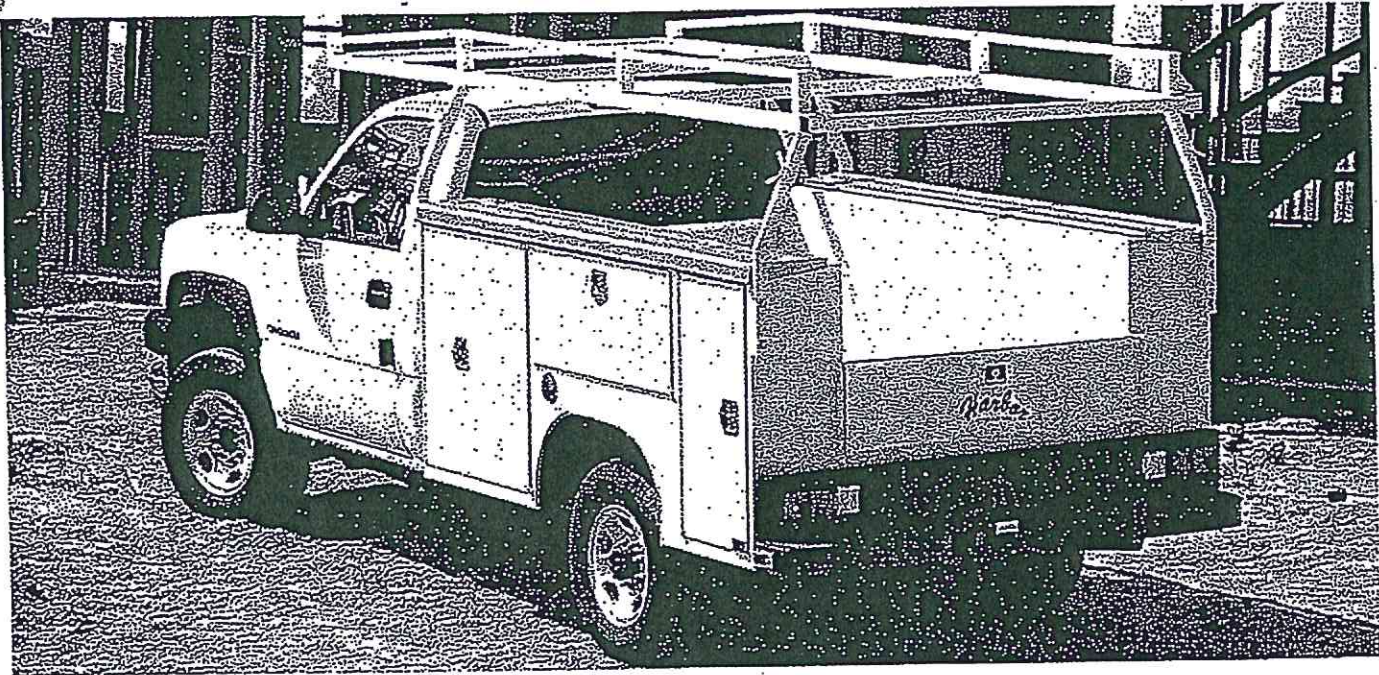


8 ft. Service Body Schematic



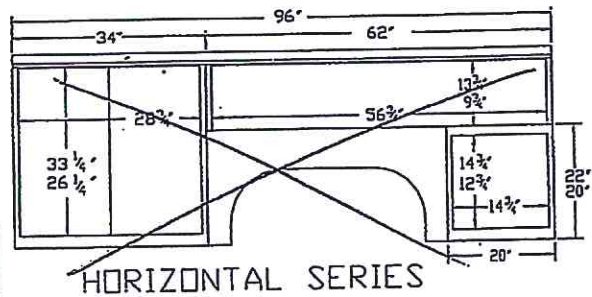
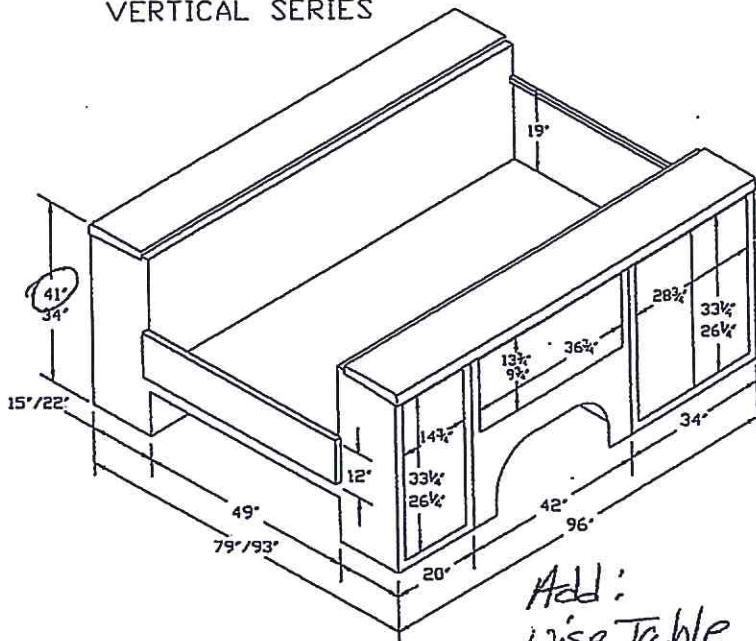

Subject: Authorize the Application of District Credit Card

BACKGROUND:

On a limited basis the Rubidoux Community Services District has a need to purchase goods and services via a credit card when suppliers, vendors and seminars do not take a District issued purchase order (P.O.). Typical credit card purchases include Board Members seminar registrations, employee training and workshops, annual employee banquet and in-house working lunches to name a few. In all of the above purchases, District employees use personal credit cards for District related services and goods. Employees are then required to complete and submit a reimbursement request for District related expenses and must now wait for Board approval. As a disclosure, the District does have a Home Depot credit card for materials and hand tools. The Home Depot card is controlled by our Manager of Fiscal Services and requested by the District Field Manager when needed.


A District Credit card would eliminate the use of employee's personal credit card purchases. Further, a District Credit Card authorization provides a mechanism which improves the efficiency and convenience of conducting District business. Staff would recommend the issuance of two (2) Credit cards – one to the Manager of Fiscal Services and the other to our District Engineer/Assistant General Manager. For checks and balances purposes, the General Manager would not be a bearer to any proposed District credit card.

Staff has reviewed three (3) potential credit cards; Capital One, Chase and CSDA. It is our recommendation based upon the limited and selective use of a District issued credit card that Chase Credit Card offers the best benefits since it offers a 5% cash back on the first \$25,000.00 on an annual basis.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends to the Rubidoux Community Services District Board of Directors the authorization to apply for the Chase Credit Card for District use. If the Board concurs, Staff request authorization to amend Draft Resolution No. 2017-833 at the next regular Board Meeting of the Rubidoux Community Services District for Adoption to effectuate the application of District Credit Card(s).

RUBIDOUX COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT

CREDIT CARD POLICY

Purpose

- Ensure that District Purchasing Card transactions are carried out as effectively as possible.
- Guard against any possible fraud and abuse of the District Purchasing Card.

Authority

General Manager, Manager of Fiscal Services, and Accounting/Budgeting Manager are responsible to ensure that the District Purchasing Card expenses are proper and reimbursable under this policy and that the expenses are reasonable and necessary. Final approval of reimbursements is under the authority of the Board.

Procedures

Card Issue

- The Rubidoux CSD provides staff with a District Purchasing Card for purchases of goods and services.
- Each District Purchasing Card has a monthly spending limit. This limit is based upon anticipated purchasing needs and is set and authorized by the General Manager and/or the Manager of Fiscal Services.

Credit Card Expenditure

- The District Purchasing Card will only be used for those activities that are direct consequences of the cardholders' function within the organization.
- Any purchase over the amount of \$250 requires written approval from the General Manager or Manager of Fiscal Services.

Cardholder's Responsibilities

- Activate and sign the back of the District Purchasing Card as soon as it is received.
- When a purchase is made, the following information should be recorded on the physical receipt:
 - If the expenditure is for a specific grant project – note the Grant Name
 - If the expenditure is for RCSD Indirect or Operating Expenses – note the budget category (Operating Supplies, Utilities, etc.)
 - Describe what was purchased – if this is not already clearly indicated on the receipt.
 - Write cardholder's name or initials on the receipt
 - Give the receipt to the Accounting/Budgeting Manager immediately.

- If the District Purchasing Card is lost or stolen report this immediately, no later than the next business day, to the Accounting/Budgeting Manager or Manager of Fiscal Services so that the Card can be cancelled.
- Review and sign a copy of the monthly statement to verify all the transactions are correct and have been made for official purposes.
- In the event of resignation, return the District Purchasing Card to the Manger of Fiscal Services.
- Cardholder shall be personally liable for any unauthorized transactions unless the Card is lost, stolen, or subject to fraud by a third party.
