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PROPOSED SOLID WASTE AGREEMENT & RATE UPDATE

Overview Summary – June 2025

Contract Amendment No. 3 – Key Provisions

- Section 1.0 'Term of Agreement':
 - The term of this Agreement shall expire on December 31, 2035; and
 - The Term of this Agreement will be extended each December 31, on an annual basis, for one additional year, making the remaining of the term seven (7) years from the date of the extension.
- Section 2.10 'No Charge Service to District':
 - Further expanded bulky item pickups' acceptable items and items not acceptable;
 - Used battery recycling drop off program at the District main office for use by residents;
 - Residences not eligible for the no additional cost barrel roll out service may subscribe to the service for an additional monthly fee;
 - Holiday tree recycling program on the two regularly scheduled collection days following Christmas Day;
 - Community clean ups 2x per year with up to five (5) Roll-Off Containers or Commercial Front End Loaders to locations specified by the District for collection of Solid Waste, Green Waste, Bulky-Items and E-Waste;
 - Collect uncontainerized Green Waste tied, bundled and placed alongside Green Waste containers in bundles of four (4) feet long and eighteen (18) inches in diameter; and
 - Used oil collection from residential Customers not to exceed 2 gallons per collection and 4 times per year.
- Section 2.18 'Street Sweeping':
 - At no charge to the District, street sweeping service will be provided two times per month on all public residential streets with curb and gutters and main arterial streets in the District.

- Section 3.2 '*Change in Cost of Doing Business*':
 - The service cost component CPI adjustment may not exceed 4% in any given year unless otherwise justified; and
 - 90-gallon residential barrel service rates shall not exceed those charged by the City of Jurupa Valley for the same level of service by more than 2.00%.

Trash Rate Update – Effective July 1, 2025 (Pending Proposition 218 Protest Hearing & Board Approval)

- Residential trash rates:
 - **Proposed Monthly Rate:** \$38.92 (90-gallon cans – solid waste (black), recycling (blue), and mixed organics (green))
 - **Increase:** \$1.57 per month (4.2%)
 - **Average Annual Increase Since Last Adjustment (July 2023):** \$0.79 per year, or 2.1%

Note: The residential trash rate matches the FY 2025|2026 rate to be charged by the City of Jurupa Valley for the same level of service (90-gallon can), ensuring uniformity and fairness for local customers. Beginning FY 2026|2027, the RCSD residential rate will never exceed the City of Jurupa Valley rate by more than 2.0%.

- Commercial trash rates:
 - Rates adjusted based on subscription and frequency. Refer to your Proposition 218 mailing or Exhibit A to Draft Resolution No. 2025-928 for more information. - New available subscription services:
 - Residential barrel pull out service
 - Commercial barrel service (35-, 65-, 90-gallon cans)
 - 2x – 6x per week (previously 1x per week only)

Board Activities Regarding Proposition 218

- **Public Hearing Scheduled:** The District Board will conduct a Proposition 218 Public Hearing and Protest Election on **June 26, 2025, at 4:00 PM** to consider adopting new residential and commercial solid waste service charges.
- **Legal and Cost Basis for Rates:** Proposed rate adjustments reflect updated contract costs, SB 1383 compliance mandates, and administrative expenses. A draft resolution (No. 2025-928) and cost data have been prepared to meet legal transparency and disclosure requirements.
- **Opportunity for Public Input:** Property owners and directly-billed customers may submit written protests before or during the hearing. Protests may be delivered in person, by mail, or by email to **admin@rcsd.org** prior to the close of the hearing.
